A: The California School Noncompliant Plumbing Fixture and Appliance Program (SNPFA) was not covered in this Webinar. It is part of that state's School Energy Efficiency Stimulus (SEES) Program – Assembly Bill 841 and is intended to provide grants to local educational agencies and state agencies to replace noncompliant plumbing fixtures and appliances that fail to meet water efficiency standards. Q: Do you have any information on Canadian Coronavirus Relief Funding

A: No. We do not have any updates regarding Canadian Coronavirus Relief Funding at this time.

Q: I use the [Sloan WES-111](#) in the majority of my facilities. Is the green antibacterial handle also resistant to COVID?

A: Sloan manual flushometer handles with anti-microbial properties have not yet been independently tested and certified for COVID resistance, so we cannot make that claim at this time. The handle that you are referring to specifically is the [Sloan WES-212](#). These handles come with an anti-microbial silver ion coating that is able to reduce microbiological contamination over time. It protects against a broad array of potentially harmful bacteria, fungi, yeast, mold, and mildew and can withstand salt spray, water soak, high humidity, and corrosion and still protect effectively, even with light scratches and abrasions.

Sloan also offers [CuVerro Flushometer Handles](#) that are made of an antimicrobial copper alloy that kills more than 99.9% of bacteria* within 2 hours. It's the only class of solid surface materials registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to actively kill bacteria*.
